

Flammable Liquid Safety Cabinets



■ NFPA 30 & OSHA: Either Manual or Self-Close are Acceptable

A manual or self close safety cabinet is accepted in all 50 states under OSHA 1910.106 and the NFPA 30 Flammable and Combustible Liquids Code. The following reference chart illustrates either a manual or self-close safety cabinet can be used. Fire Codes may prevail and require self-close doors though. It is important to also check with state and local fire code to see if safety cabinets with self-close doors are required. We recommend customers check with local authorities having jurisdiction as local code may prevail.
